HQ 10 Corps

1. APS Kota

- (a) Mentor system is planned for below average learners. Teachers are given group of 5-7 students who take care of their academics.
- (b) Parents & students counseling is being carried out regularly.
- (c) Distribution of Question Bank through CDs to students of IX to XII is being done.

2. APS Suratgarh

- (a) Conduct of Regular Yoga Classes.
- (b) Organising Dance, Music & Skill Development and coaching for Sainik School for two hours in the evening.

3. Faridkot
